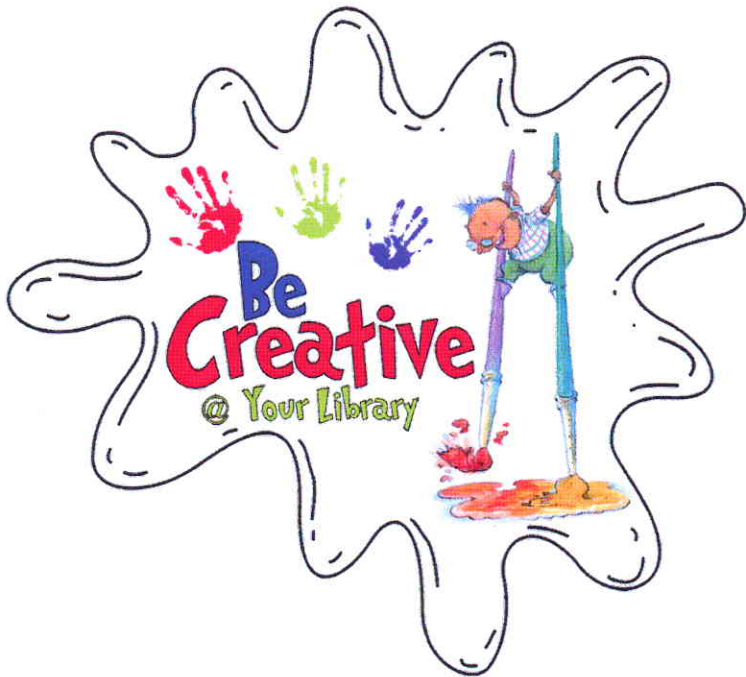


Summer Reading 2009

If you can't make it to the program, stop in and sign up anytime after June 29th.

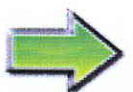

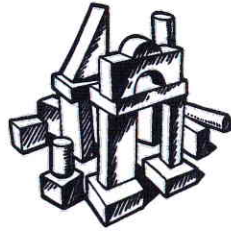
Mondays at 9:30: Storytime for Two-year-olds
