Representatives from Radio Shack will speak about the conversion to digital TV in 2009 and what you need to do to be ready!

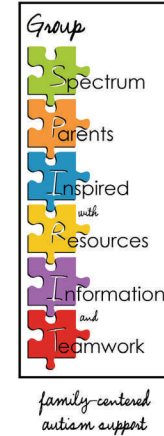
