

1. What is eLibraryNJ?

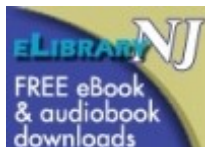
eLibraryNJ is a subscription service that provides downloadable ebooks and audiobooks to participating New Jersey public libraries. In order to borrow items from eLibraryNJ, your home library must subscribe to this service.

2. Which devices are supported by eLibraryNJ?

- PC or Mac computer
- Apple iPad/iPhone/iPod
- Amazon Kindle
- Barnes & Noble Nook
- Sony Reader
- More listed on the eLibraryNJ site

3. What types of materials are available?

- Kindle Books
- Adobe EPUB eBooks
- Adobe PDF eBooks
- OverDrive WMA Audiobooks
- OverDrive MP3 Audiobooks

4. How do I get started?

You will need:

- A valid Scotch Plains library card
- A computer or device with Internet access
- Free software for the computer or device you wish to use. The website will show you how to download this software the first time you check materials out.

Then simply access eLibraryNJ through the link on our website: www.scotlib.org to begin browsing.



5. What if a title I want isn't available?

In this case, you have the option to place a title on hold, with a limit of 5 titles. When your requested title becomes available, you will get an email alert, after which you must download the title within 3 days.



6. How do I check out ebooks or audiobooks?

- Click “Add to Cart” (you may check out up to 5 items).
- Click “Proceed to Checkout”.
- Select “Scotch Plains Public Library”.
- Sign in with your library card barcode and PIN (usually the last 4 digits in your phone number).
- “Confirm” checkout.
- Click “Download”.
- Once the item is downloaded, you may transfer it to another device (e-reader, iPod, CD, etc.).
- When the item is due, the file will expire automatically – no overdue fines!

7. How do I download an ebook to my Kindle?

- Follow the previous instructions to check out a title.
- Click the “Get for Kindle” button. This opens the Amazon.com website. You may be required to sign in with your Amazon.com account if you are not already logged in.
- Select a Kindle device or reading app. Click the “Get library book” button and sync your device or app to download the book, or choose to send it to your device via USB.
- If you choose to purchase the book from the Kindle Store or check it out again at a later date, all of your notes and highlights will be preserved.
