

FALL CRAFTS

NOTE: For these crafts you will need to collect leaves that are not fully crinkled, wash and dry them.

Leaf rubbing

Supplies need: crayons, plain paper, & leaves

Directions: Place leaves down on a surface and put your paper on top, have your child rub a crayon over where the leaf is.

Interactive tips: Once they're done coloring, ask them how many points or veins the leaves have.



Leaf Wreath

Supplies need: leaves, glue stick, paper plate, scissors

Directions: After you cut the center out of your paper plate, have your child decorate their plate with the leaves by gluing them down.

Interactive tips: See if your child can create a pattern with the leaves or say each color.



Leaf Painting

Supplies need: leaves, washable paint, paint brush

Directions: Lay leaves flat on your surface (you may need to put a book on top to make sure it's fully flat) and have your child paint their leaves!

Interactive tips: Read a book about mixing colors like *Mouse paint* by Ellen Stoll Walsh or *Mix it up!* by Hervé Tullet and see if you can duplicate some of the color blends
